Please read the following specifications to apply for and to be in Santas Workshop. ***There are changes that you need to be aware of.*** Please take time to read these rules to prevent any problems or delays in your chance of getting a booth.

While booths will be reserved on a **first-come** basis, **we cannot guarantee booth position or special requests**. We reserve the right to deny any crafter or craft into the show.

No distributors.

Craftspeople may register and set up booths on **Thursday night, November 18, 2010** starting at **4p.m.** If you can't make it til Friday Nov 19<sup>th</sup> you may have access to building at 7:30 a.m.

Craftspeople must provide their **own tables, chairs and table covers.** Extension cords must be three-prong, grounded cords, or they are subject to being cut by inspectors. **All tables must be covered this year.**

**Each booth must be staffed and ready for business no later than the opening of the show each day.**

Displays/booths must be contained in the reserved area for your booth.

No pets are allowed in the booths.

Booths must be stocked and staffed from opening until closing all three days. No packing will be allowed until 8:00 pm on Friday 7:00 p.m..Saturday, and 5:00 pm on Sunday unless you have **prior permission** from the chairman.

*CJWC* will provide security during closed hours. During show hours, security is the crafters responsibility.

*CJWC* will charge a \$30.00 fee for each returned check.

No pins, nails, wires, twist ties, HAY, or similar objects can be dropped on the Pavilion floor as these endanger the animals.

The crafter is responsible to clean their booth space after the show.

*CJWC* has and will reserve the right to refuse space in future show to anyone who violates any of these specifications.

There will be NO electrical hook-ups for RVs or campers.

**TTU Hyder-Burks Pavilion will not allow any readily edible food items to be sold.**

**Booth sizes and fees are as follows:**

Single \$100            10 feet wide by 5 feet deep

Double \$150           18 feet wide by 6 feet deep

Double Plus \$200    20 feet wide by 10 feet deep

Please send your non refundable application fee of \$20 (payable to Santas Workshop) and current pictures of your booth items no later than **July 15th, 2010** to be in the first group of confirmations.
